

## PRECIOUS IN HIS SIGHT: MADAGASCAR

Here's your chance to bring food and other critical items to the precious little ones in the foot-shaped island nation of Madagascar. Madagascar is considered one of the poorest countries in the world. Poorer than Haiti. Poorer than Uganda. You have the opportunity to serve at least 4,000 desperately impoverished children and older folks.

We will be focusing on Malagasy Lutheran "revival" centers not served by other international organizations or groups. Such centers serve as compassionate safe havens for an amazing mix of outcasts and orphans, the addicted and abandoned, the physically and mentally ill, the tormented and the strange. Lutheran "shepherds" and other lay leaders—themselves incredibly poor—provide tender care to other incredibly poor people.

Your gifts of Kids Against Hunger emergency food packets, school and health supplies, and other needed items will be packed into a 40-foot container, shipped to Madagascar (200 miles off the southeast coast of Africa), and distributed by our Lutheran partners.

  - We'll be responsible for shipping, clearing through customs, storing, transporting, and distributing your gifts safely and efficiently.

- \_\_\_ \$40 will provide a family with stainless steel pot for small rocket stove.

- \_\_\_ Good condition sheets and towels
- \_\_\_ Quilts (Any size. Handmade tied quilts are great)
- \_\_\_ Health Care.
  - o Band Aids, gauze pads & bandages
  - o New soaps, tooth brushes, toothpaste (*please place soap in airtight bag*)
  - o Antibiotic and antifungal creams (Lamisil is super-effective)
  - o Children's and women's vitamins
  - o Aspirin, ibuprofen, Tylenol, Motrin
  - o Crutches, wheelchairs, walkers
- \_\_\_ Educational supplies
  - o Backpacks
  - o Colored pencils, markers, paint sets
  - o New ballpoint pens, pencils, notebooks
- \_\_\_ Recreational items (new or in excellent condition)
  - o Soccer balls
  - o Basketballs
- \_\_\_ Sewing supplies and fabric
  - o Fabric, preferably cotton, cotton/blend
  - o WHITE fabric, for shepherds' robes)
  - o Sewing notions, scissors, thread, elastic, pins, needles, metric tape measure, buttons, etc.

  - o Yarn for knitting and crocheting afghans, hats, and mittens
